## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The event is open to Amateur Women Members of any golf club affiliated with Golf Australia. Evidence of such membership and current Golf Australia handicap must be produced to the Tournament Committee upon request.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. **A refund of an entry fee will not be considered after the closing date for entries.**
3. The Tournament Committee has the power to vary the tournament conditions, rule on any dispute and may, at any time, refuse an entry or declare an entrant ineligible to compete. The Committee shall have the entire management of the event, and all decisions of the Committee shall be final.
4. Each competitor must check-in at the Proshop 30-minutes prior to scheduled tee time. A competitor who is not on their allocated tee and ready to hit off may be subject to a penalty under Rule 5.3. A siren will sound at 08:30am to commence play.
5. In the event of a tie for the overall gross winner, the champion will be determined by a play-off over holes 1, 8 and 9, then sudden death over the same holes. All other ties will be determined by countback.
6. Only one major trophy shall be awarded to any one player.
7. Nearest to the pin on the 16th hole – only those who have entered by gold coin in the Golden Bucket are eligible for this NTP. Entry must be prior to the siren announcing play can commence. The Proshop staff will note your entry on the booking sheet.
8. Divisions will be determined by the number of entries.
9. Contact the Proshop to book a cart, 02 6281 1888.
10. Caddies are not permitted.
11. Miscore will be used for scoring. Mobile phones must be in silent/flight mode. Scorecards will be available for players without access to Miscore.

A player may use a mobile phone for the following uses only:

- As a distance measuring device
- To look up the R&A Rules and/or Decisions of Golf
- In case of an emergency
- It must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc) otherwise the player will be in breach of Rule 4.3.

NB: If a phone is used outside of these parameters, it will be considered a breach of these conditions.
